Healy School faces east onto Beaverland Street in the city's Castle Rouge neighborhood. Its site occupies most of a city block, though several houses exist on the southern end. Healy School is a small two-story brick building with a rectangular plan, built in 1949. The site also features a freestanding boiler house. The southern two-thirds of the site consist of a grassy playfield.
